## FAMILY IDENTIFICATION CARD APPLICATION



The Family Identification Card provides opportunities for the spouse/domestic partner and children of enrolled students to participate in designated campus programs and activities, including library privileges and student discounts. To obtain a Family Identification Card, enrolled students must bring valid student ID and appropriate documentation as listed below to the office of Non-Traditional Student Services (Student Services Building, Rm. 484). Appropriate documentation for spouse/domestic partner can include any of the following: marriage license/domestic partnership agreement; joint mortgage or lease; joint checking account; joint credit account, joint ownership of vehicle; etc. Documentation for children: birth certificate (copies accepted.)

In addition, cards must be renewed each semester to maintain eligibility for the program. Contact (618) 453-7521 for details.

## **Family Benefits**

<u>Morris Library:</u> Offers a **free loan courtesy card**. Student must accompany spouse/domestic partner to obtain the courtesy card. A valid photo id and the Family Identification Card will be required. Loan Courtesy cards must be renewed each semester.

<u>Saluki Express:</u> Students may purchase a pass for their family member for a discounted rate. Pass must be renewed each semester. Student must accompany family member to the Central Ticket Office on the second floor of the Student Center to purchase a pass. Valid photo ID will be required and Family Identification Card from our office must be presented at time of purchase to receive.

<u>Saluki Food Pantry</u>: The Saluki Food Pantry, located in the Student Center's lower level, provides food to students in need. A student's spouse/partner may pick up food for the family when presenting the Family ID card (initial visit requires student to be present). One visit per month, per family please.

<u>Student Recreation Center</u>: Students may purchase a **spouse/partner membership at a reduced rate** from the Student Recreation Center's administrative office (visit <u>reccenter.siu.edu</u> for membership details). Students with children may purchase a **membership for ALL of their children for only \$15** each semester.

<u>SIU Student Health Services</u>: An SIU student may enroll his/her eligible dependents in the SIU Student Health Insurance plan. For details and eligibility requirements, visit <u>shc.siu.edu</u> and select Health Insurance.

<u>SIU Athletics</u>: Students may purchase **general admission athletic event tickets** for members listed on Family Identification Card for **iust \$5 per ticket** (present Family Identification Card and valid Student ID at Athletics ticket office).

<u>Wesley Foundation Food Pantry</u>: The Wesley Foundation food pantry on campus provides food to students in need. A student's spouse/partner may pick up food for the family when presenting the Family ID card. One visit per month, per family please.
